HEADTEACHER MESSAGE




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MRS WILSON'S UGANDA ASSEMBLY

- Parent/Carer Consent & Medical form


It is important that these forms are submitted by Wednesday 10th July 2024 for preparation for the new academic year. These forms are requested annually to ensure all our records are up-to-date.



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
